

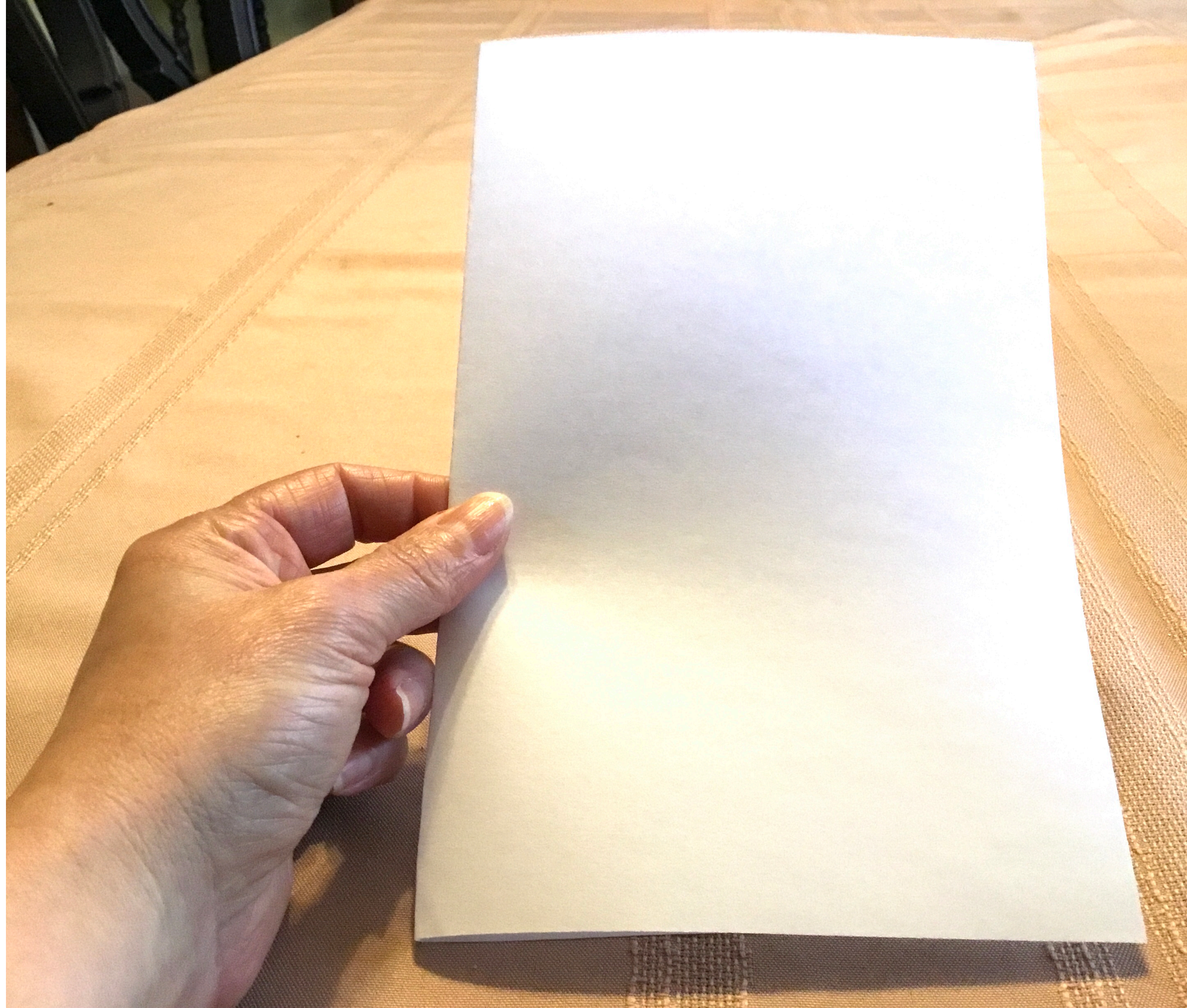
Bible Author Matthew Craft Instructions

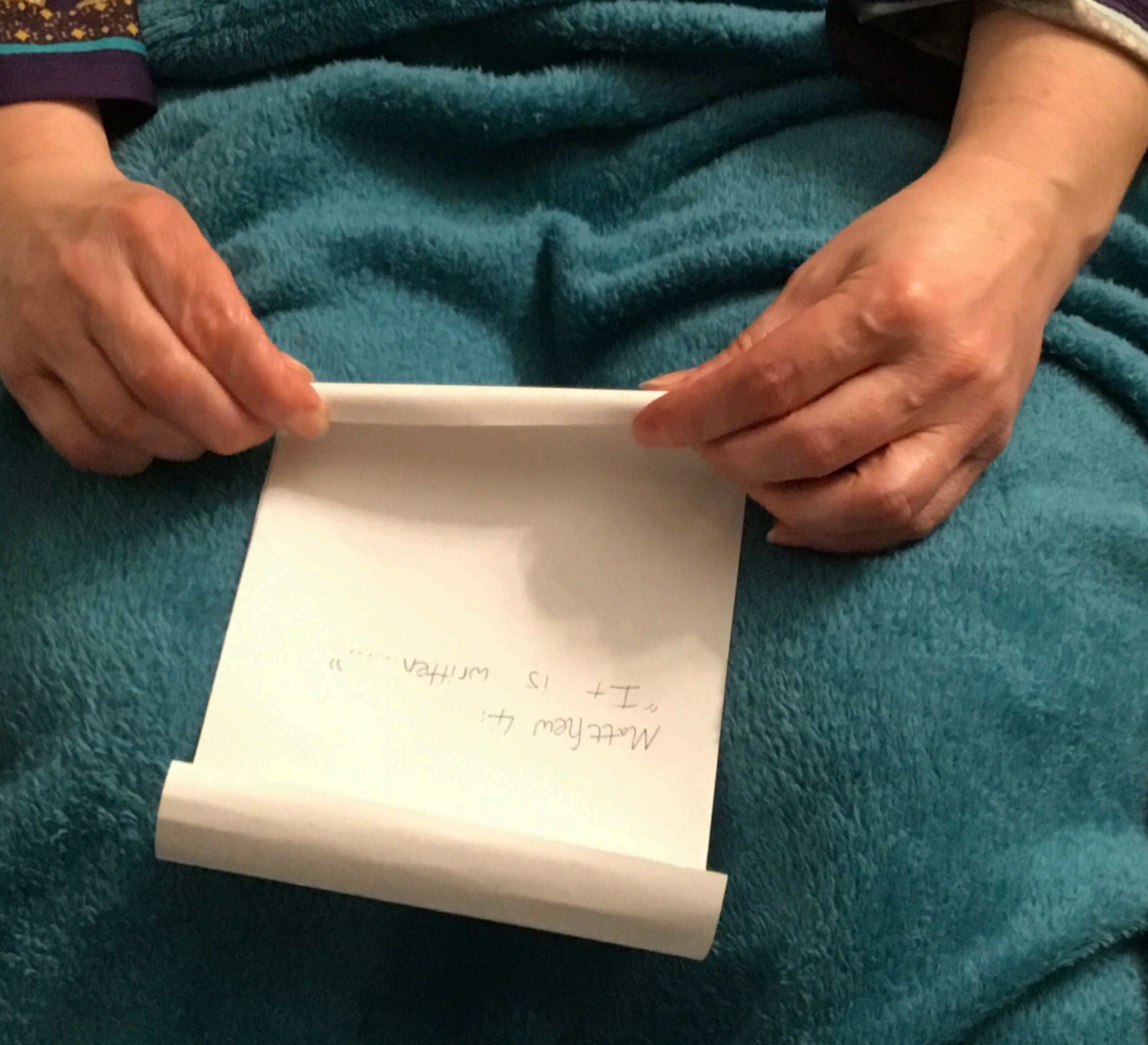
Materials: One A4 paper, a pencil, a fine marker or pen, and a way to attach: can be tape, stapler, or glue stick.

Matthew 4:
"It is written..."

**Fold
paper in
half like a
card and
cut along
the fold.**





**Use a pencil
to curl the
short
bottom
edge
upward.**

Matched 4:
"It is written..."

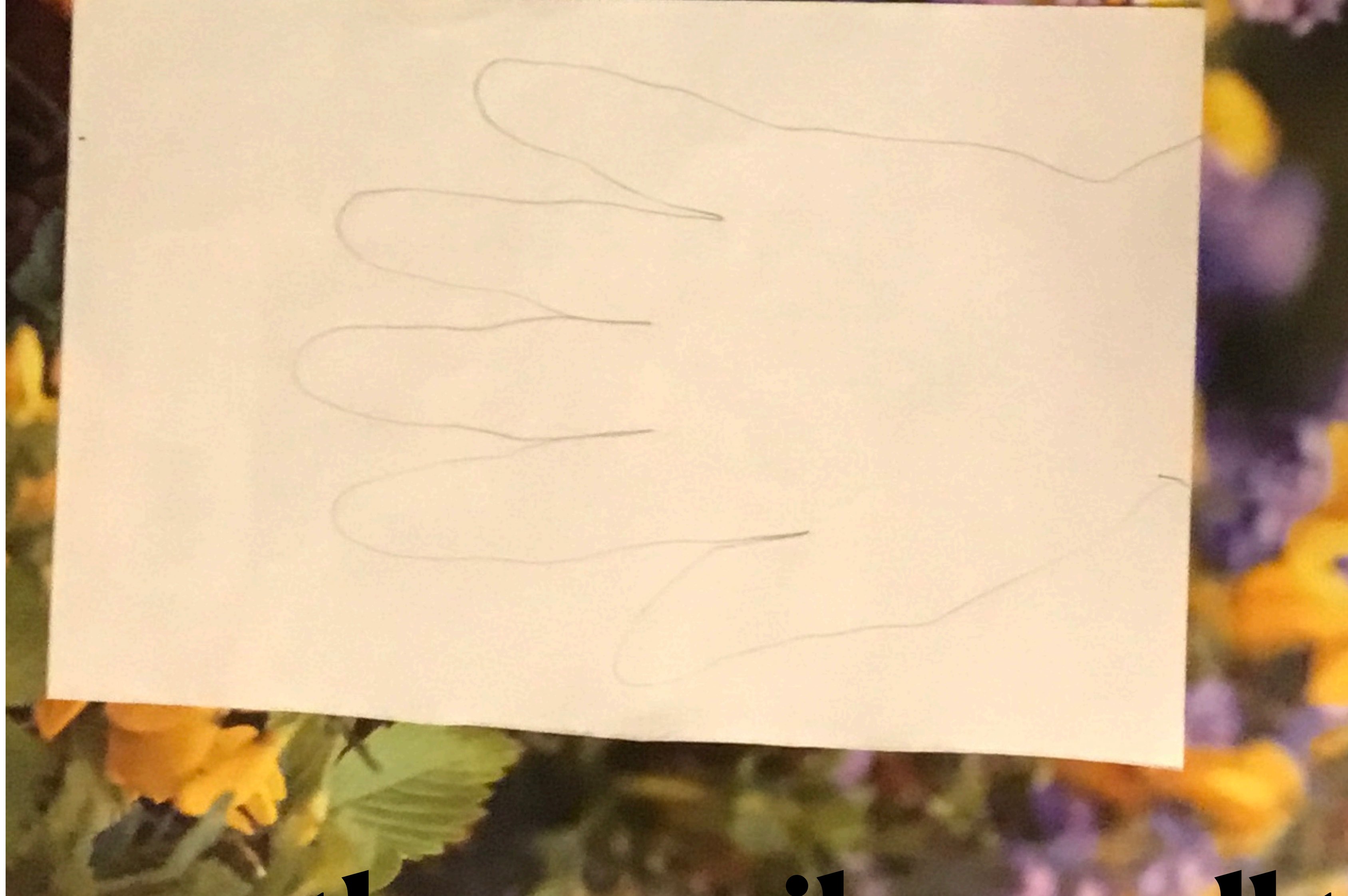
Do the same for the short top edge.

**Write in the
center:
Matthew 4:
“It is written...”**

Matthew 4:
“It is written.....”



**On other half
of the page
trace your
right hand
with fingers
slightly apart.
Leave a little
room above
your fingers
for the pencil
shape we will
draw.**



Make sure the pencil goes all the way between each finger.

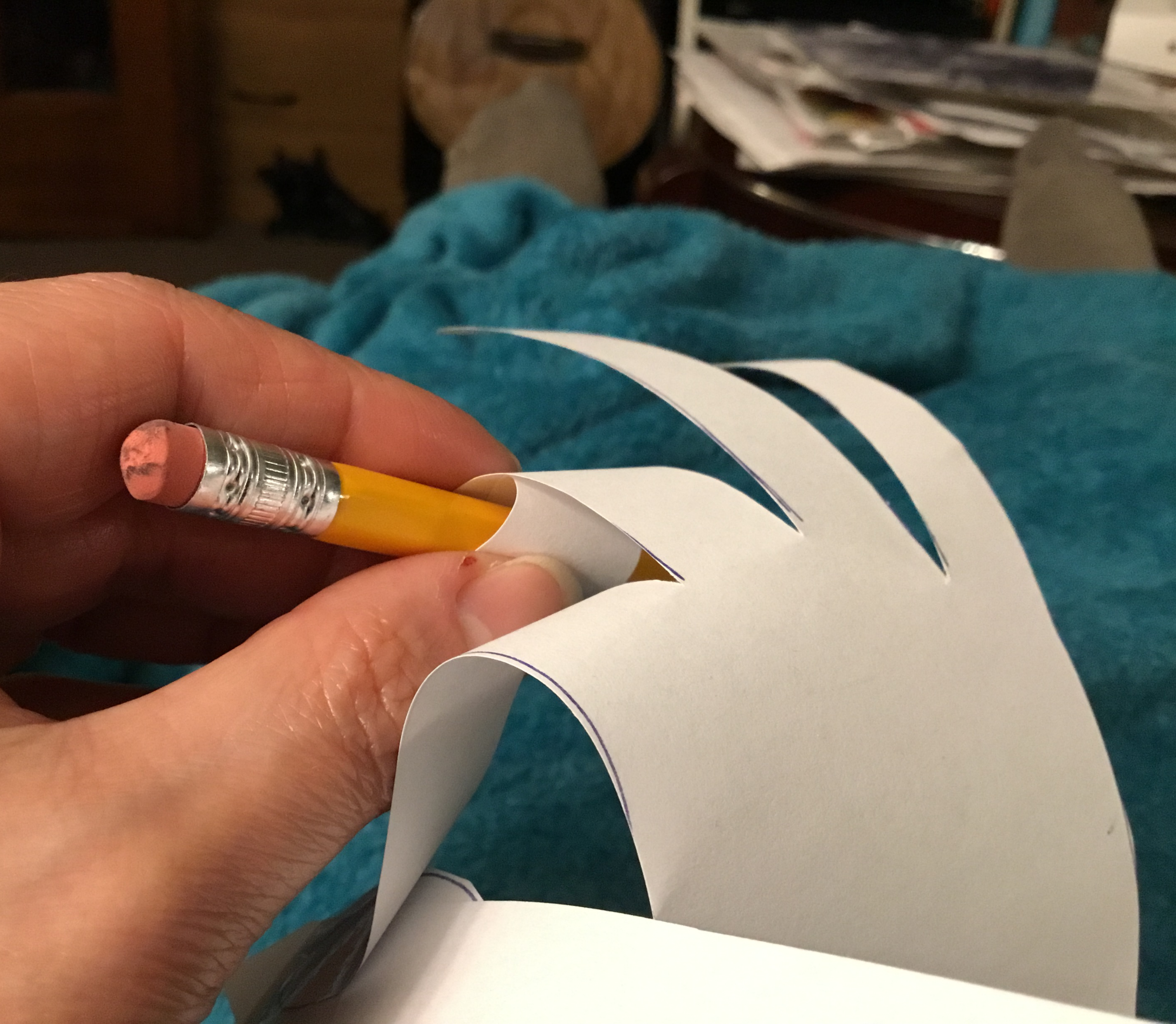


Draw a pencil at the top.

**Cut out the hand tracing
and the pencil shape.**

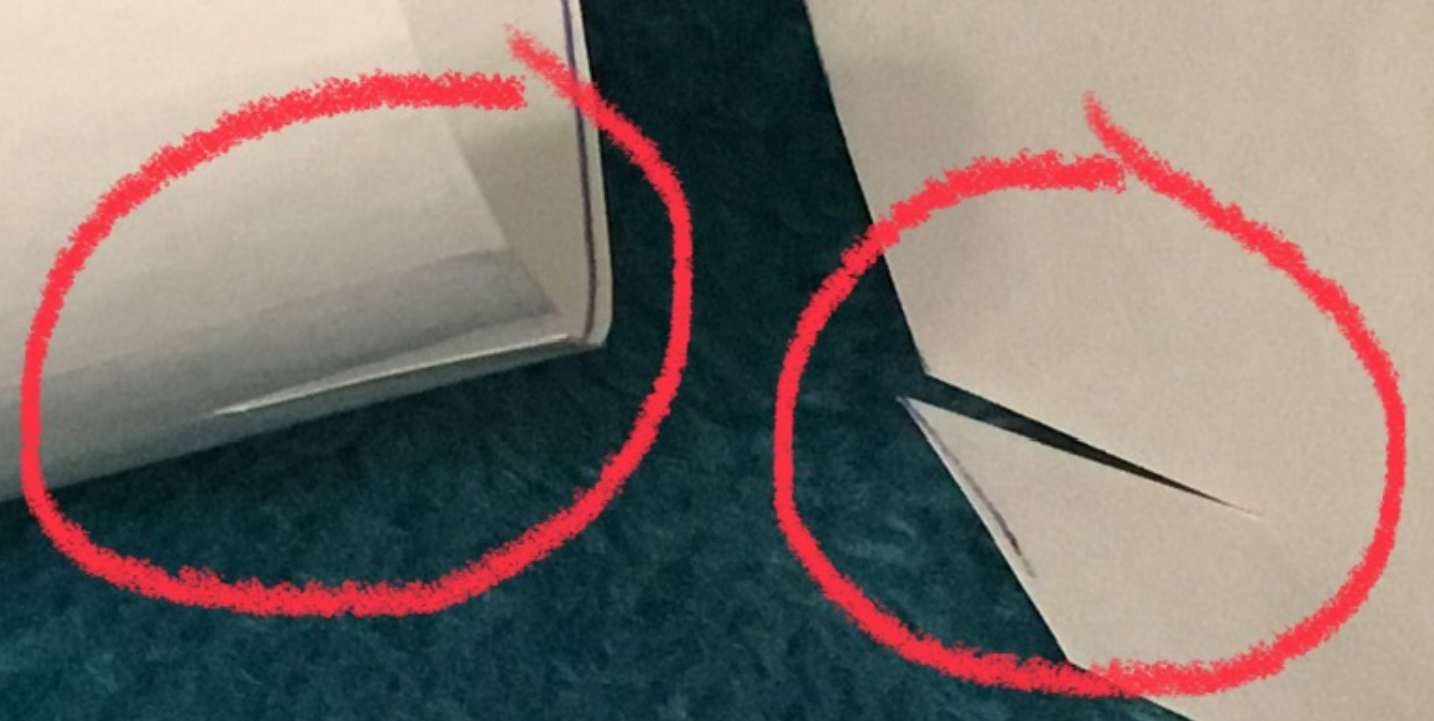


Sandwich the pencil tip between thumb and pointer finger. Tape, staple, or glue them together.



**Curl each
of the
remaining
3 fingers
under, one
at a time.**

Matt New 4:
"It is written....."



Make a slit below thumb that will fit with a slit on bottom right of scroll, right where it starts to curl.



**Fit slits
together
so that
pencil
lands near
writing.**
