
The Lion Shall Lay With the Lambcraft


Set up paper with dotted fold lines to right and left of center line, about 4 cmapart. Divide left side into three equal parts.



Draw lion. Cut a door below and flip upward to draw lamb.




Draw a left-facing lamb with a strip coming up from his back. Draw a line to right of lion's paws.



Cut out lamb and strip. Cut around strip.



Cut out lion, leaving strip to right of paws for flowers later.



On that strip coming up from lamb's back, you must put a small piece of tape at the end, with sticky side facing you.





Fold Lion forward.






Curl lamb's strip backward and attach to floor, so that lamb's head cuddles against lion's back.





Fold three extra pieces any way you like to make flowerbeds.





Draw rounded flowerbeds and cut the excess off.





You did it!!
