
### Chair Craft By Sandra McTiernan



## This chair instruction does not include the man. You can get four chairs from one piece ot paper.









# Materials: Copy paper, scissors, ruler, tape, pencil. Fold in half like a card.








# open it up.



# Measure and make a mark at 5cm from the fold line.



# Make a mark at 5cm from end of page near other mark.



# Make another 5cm mark on other side of fold, in line with other marks.

# Fold foward like an accordian.



# Fold back into a card.




Then fold front legs downwards towards the seat of chair. Fold at the mark.





Like this.






# You should have this. The back leg is double ply.





### Make a mark every 5cm for cutting it into four chairs.






# Drawa cut line every 5 cm crossing against the folds.






#### Cut one cut for now. Put aside large piece to make more chairs later, if desired.



# This is what you should have.



# Make a short snip cut at bottom of seat on back leg on both sides. This is a two-ply back leg. Cut through both.





# You can fold both rear leg edges backwards or forwards. Whatever you think looks best.



# Do the same for the front legs. Snip and fold backwards.





# cut an arched "door" shape in the front and back.

### Round the top of back of chair with scissors. Yaayyy! It's done! You can make three more if you like.
