Craft Instructions:

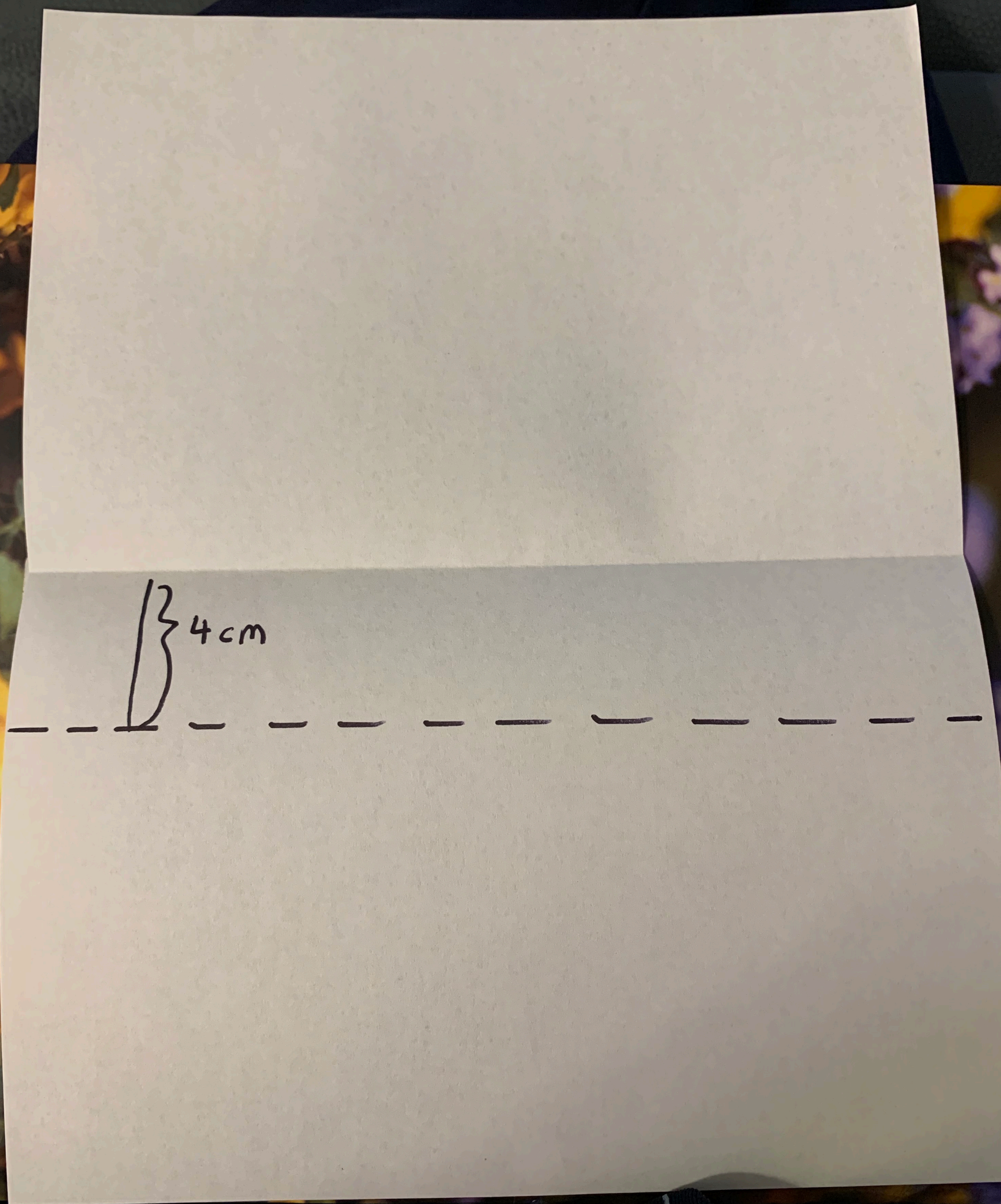
Materials: One A4 copy paper, scissors, black marker, tape is optional, ruler might be needed.

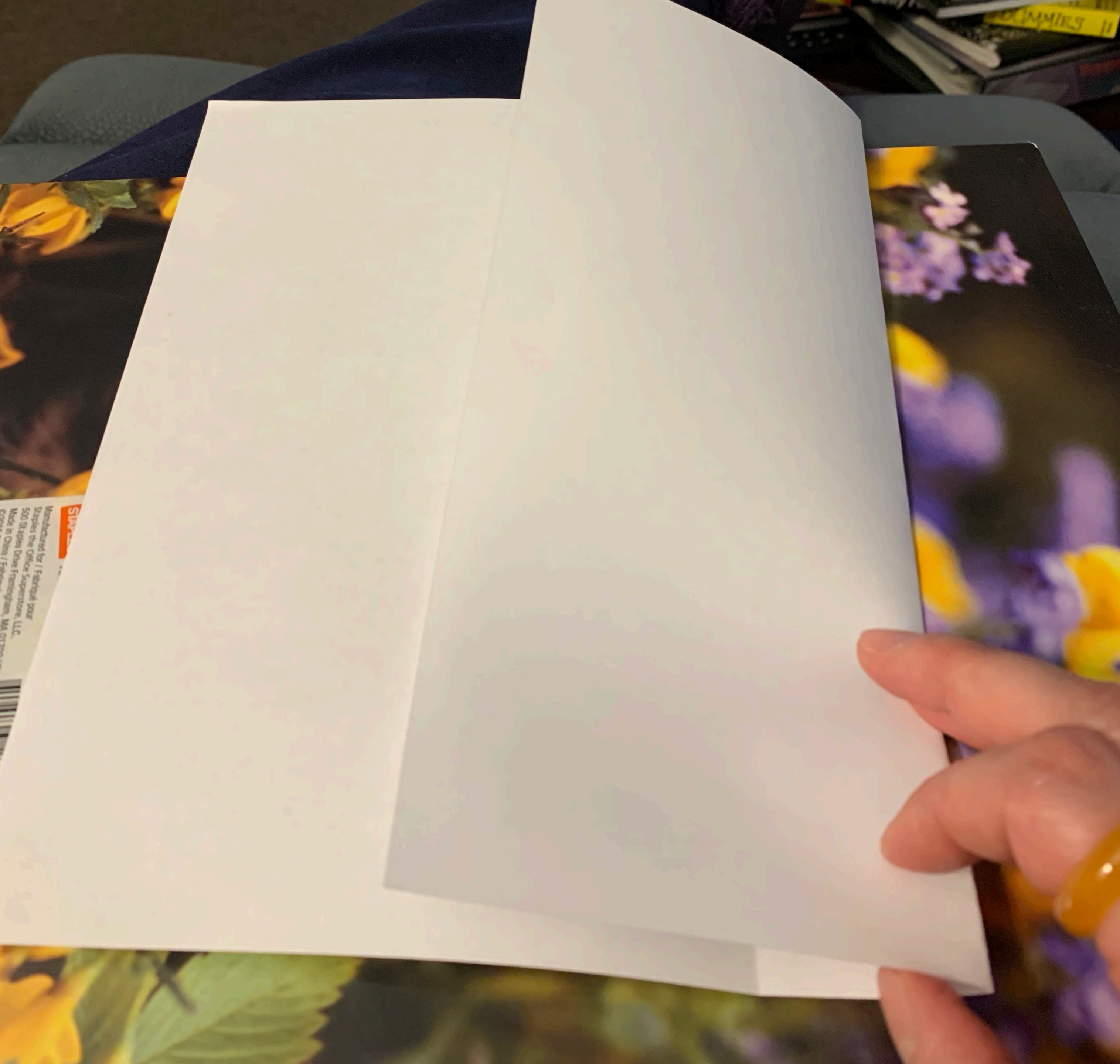

Fold A4 paper in half like a card.

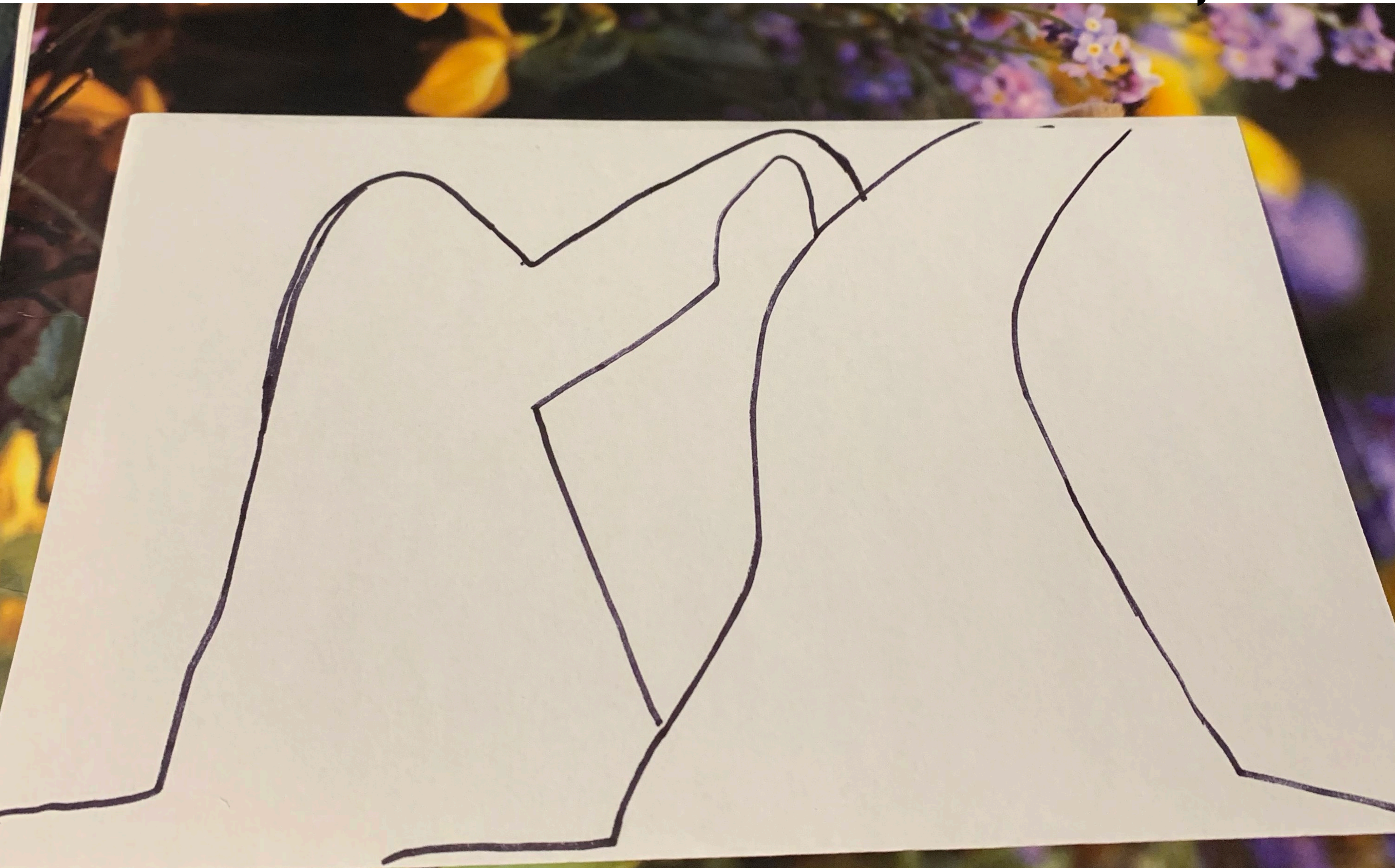


**Open paper up.
Measure about
4cm below the
crease and draw a
dotted fold line.**



Fold upward along your fold line. Now you have a “ground” in the middle of the creases, a short flap, and a taller flap.

**Flip over. Fold tall flap backward and draw this.
The middle crease is at the bottom. These are your cut lines.**

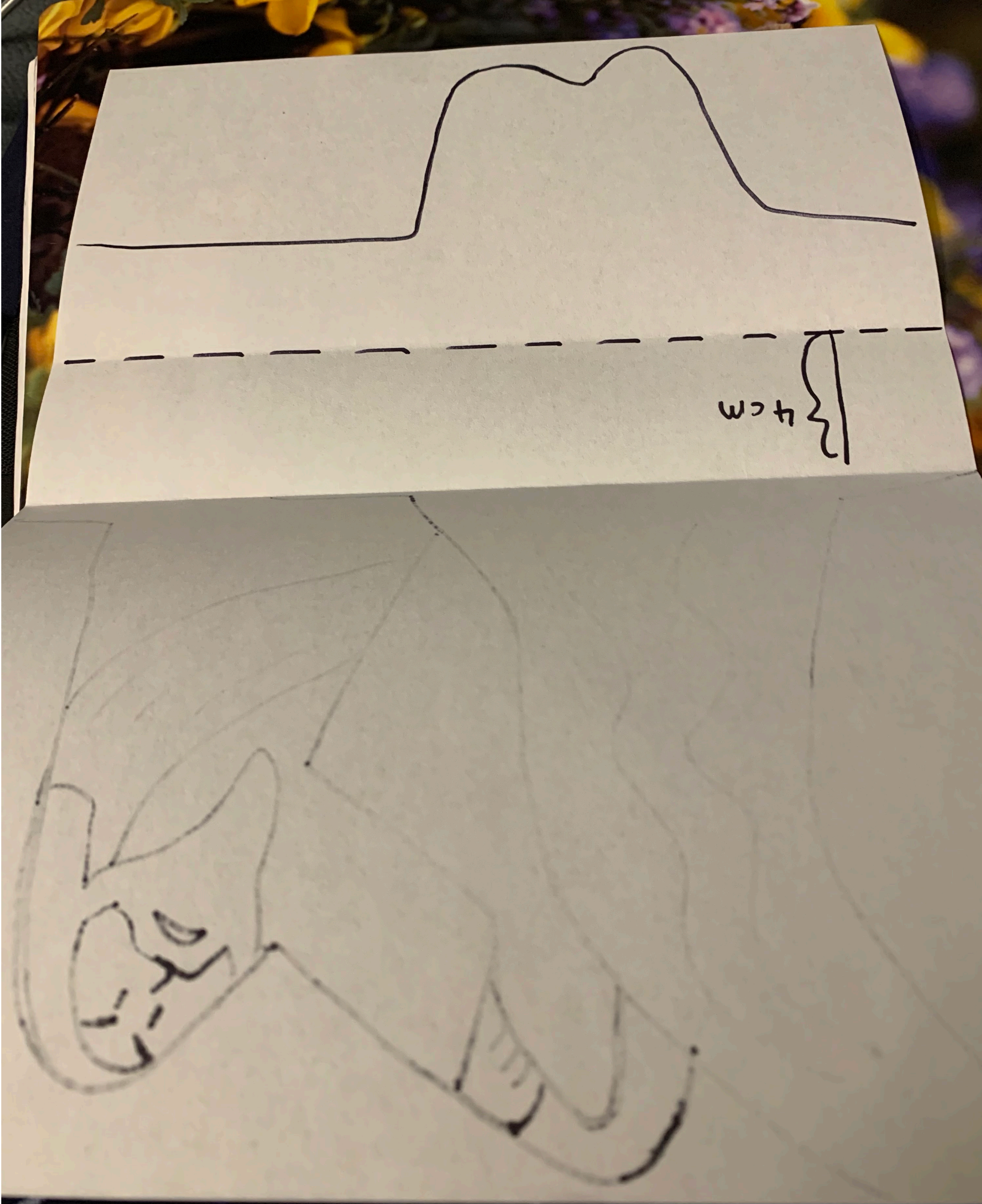




You can add inner drawings now or later.

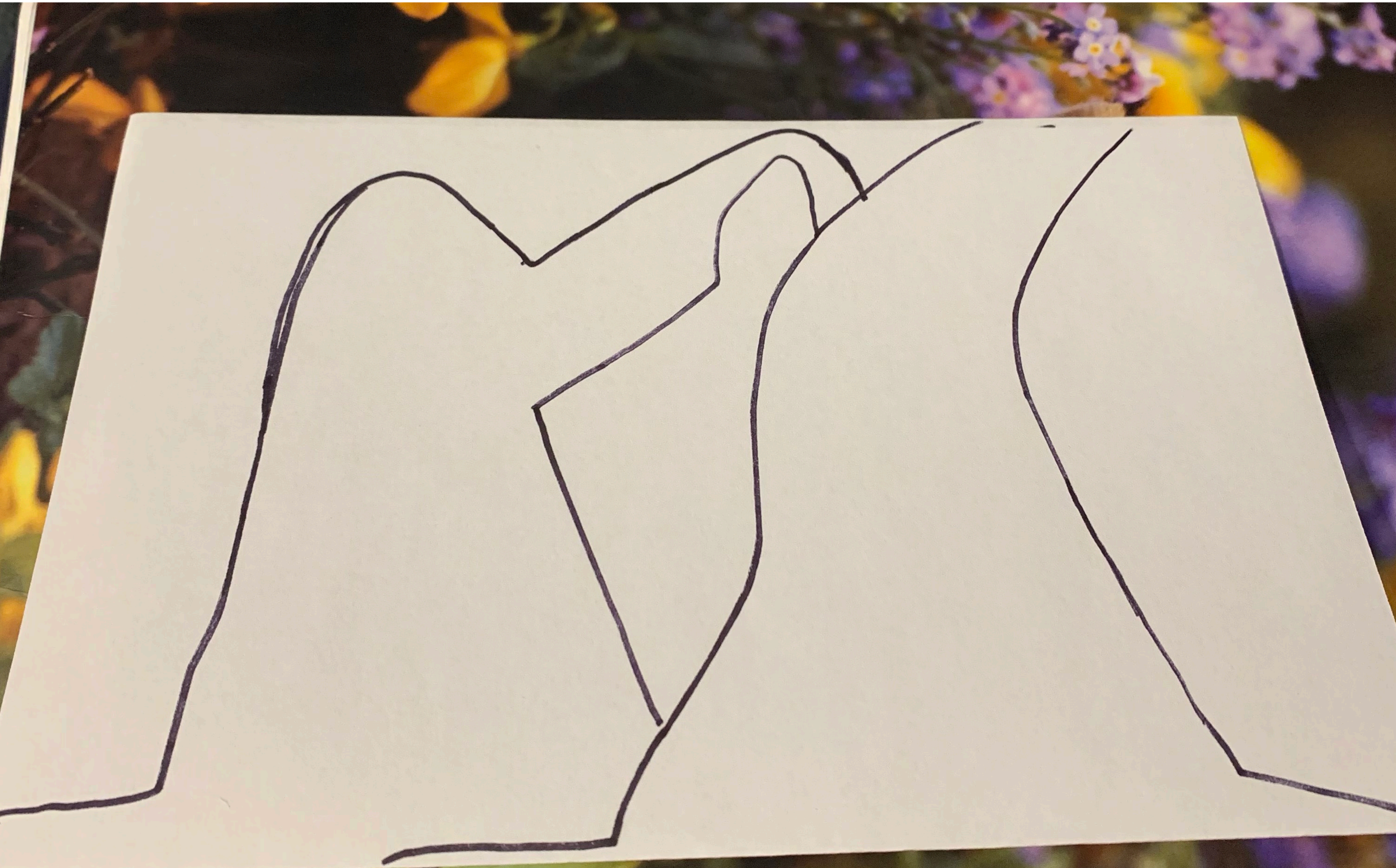


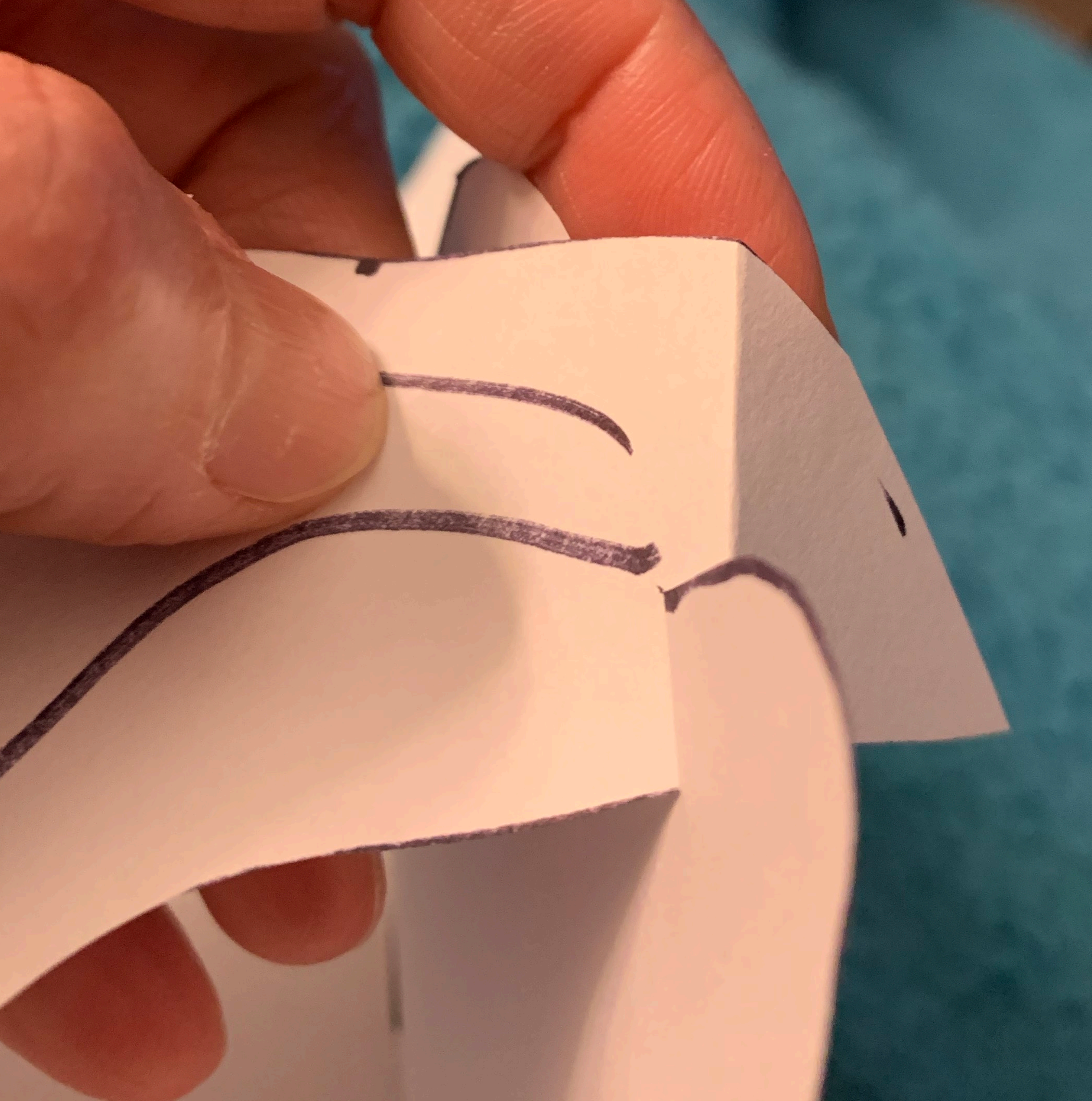
**Lift
Moses
flap up
and draw
the rock
behind
the water
flow.**



Here's another view. Cut your rock line just as you drew.

Front: Remember which are your cut lines. Go ahead and cut them.

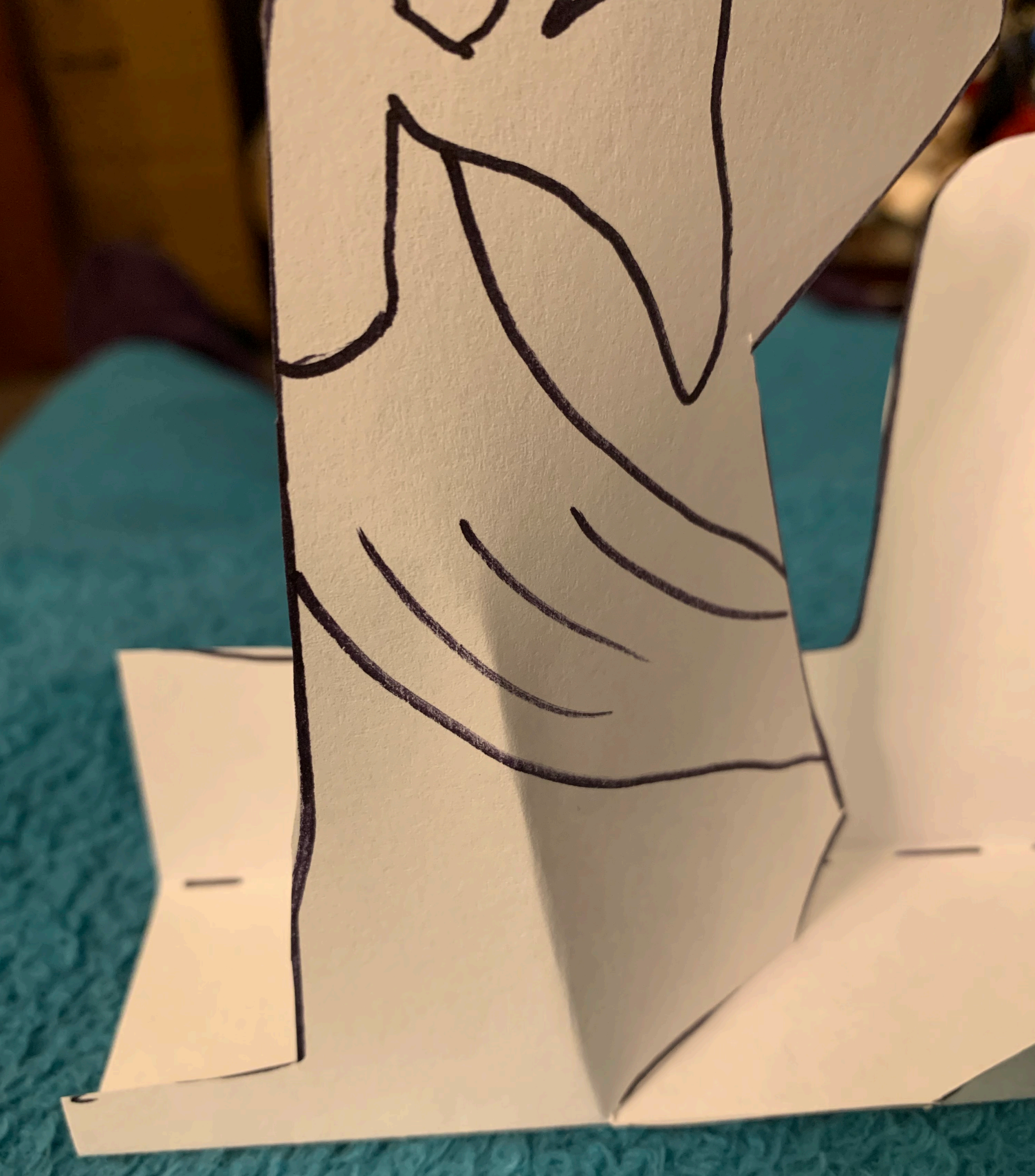




The top of the water flow should be folded over the top of the rock. You can make a slit in the rock to hold it. Or you can tape it.
